



## Notice of Motions

### Basketball

#### Motion 1

John Davidson, Bow Valley, moves that outside of the Rocky View league schedule, players can play unlimited games in tournament play. Seconded by Danny Eveleigh, Springbank.

**Rationale:** Schools in Rocky View, most notably smaller schools, must book their tournaments well in advance. If players for the Senior team are ineligible to play because of injury, holiday, or other then it is necessary to pull up grade ten players from the Junior team or to pull out of the tournament. The original rule was created to protect the integrity of "Rocky View competition", and these tournaments do not play a role in that. It must also be noted that the ASAA and our zone do not have rules to restrict the movement of grade 10's from junior to senior teams.

**Coaches' Vote:** Passed with 17 in favour, 1 abstained

#### Motion 2

Danny Eveleigh, Springbank, moved that RVSA be contacted for special circumstances if a grade 10 varsity player needs to play down during league play with the junior varsity team after the 2 game limit has already been played. Seconded by John Davidson, Bow Valley.

**Rationale:** While the two game limit for a varsity player to play down with the junior varsity team still remains in place for Rocky View league play, sometimes special circumstances arise where multiple forfeits could occur because the junior varsity team finds itself with not enough players for a league game. The move is not meant for strategic reasons or to win more games, rather it is to enable the school to field a team.

**Coaches' Vote:** Unanimously passed with 18 in favour.

#### Motion 3

Player/coach gets removed from a game suspended next game automatically (league/divisionals). A player accumulates 3 technicals he/she sits the next league/divisional game. Every technical after 3 is another game suspension thereafter.

All in favour.

### Golf

#### Motion 4

Ken Payne, George McDougall, moved that, unless the Zone tournament is on the same day, schools that intend to compete at Zones are required to play at the divisional tournament. Bruce Kaufman, WG Murdoch, seconded the motion.

**Rationale:** In order to keep numbers up, we need all Rocky View schools to participate.

**Coaches' Vote:** Unanimously passed with 5 in favour.

#### Motion 5

Rob Wilson, Chestermere, moved that we change the 18-hole qualifying round score for girls from 150 to 125. Mike Sera, Bert Church, seconded the motion.

**Rationale:** A score between 125 and 150 is still too high. This motion would make the policy the same for both boys and girls.

**Coaches' Vote:** Unanimously passed with 5 in favour.

#### Motion 6



## Notice of Motions

Bruce Kaufman, WG Murdoch, moved that coaches declare a team of four grade 9 athletes, then take the best two of three scores on each hole. Ken Payne, George McDougall, seconded the motion.

**Rationale:** This motion would align our grade 9 process with what we already do with senior/high school golf. It would also allow more grade 9s to participate.

**Coaches' Vote:** Unanimously passed with 5 in favour.

### Volleyball

#### Motion 7

Landon Thompson, Cochrane, moved that we book one official for both junior and senior varsity matches. Mike Sera, Bert Church, seconded the motion.

**Rationale:** For about 80 per cent of our games we're only getting one official anyway. Coverage has decreased steadily.

**Coaches' Vote:** Unanimously passed with 7 in favour.

#### Motion 8

Tanya Everson, Chestermere, moved that junior and senior varsity girls teams travel together and junior and varsity boys teams travel together, swapping early game times mid-way through the season. Carol Smith, Bert Church, seconded the motion.

**Rationale:** Genders were split so that junior varsity could play with one official and senior could play with two. Since we're only getting (or booking if above motion passes through Parameters) one official then genders can go back to playing together.

**Coaches' Vote:** Unanimously passed with 7 in favour.

#### Motion 9

Tim Masse, George McDougall, moved that the junior and senior boys add one game against their geographic rival - i.e. Cochrane vs. Bow Valley, George McDougall vs. Bert Church, Chestermere vs. Springbank - with home and home series wins counting one point each. Robyn Cumlin, Chestermere, seconded the motion.

**Rationale:** Boys get only five games during the season with long gaps because of bye weeks.

**Coaches' Vote:** Passed with 5 in favour, 1 abstained
